 - **Legal Obligation** To meet our accounting, invoicing, and regulatory compliance duties.
- To improve our website, services, and client experience Legal Basis:
 - **Legitimate Interests** To analyze usage data and feedback to enhance functionality and user satisfaction.

3. Data Retention

We retain personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this policy or to comply with legal obligations. When personal data is no longer required, we securely delete or anonymize it.

When a potential client becomes our client, their personal data—such as contact details, contract documents, and communication history—will not be associated with the operational data they provide to us in the course of service delivery. This may include trading data of their clients, employee performance data, or other client-related data relevant to brokers and proprietary trading firms. We retain this data only as long as necessary to fulfill our contractual obligations and to ensure the proper delivery and improvement of our services.
